

COUNCIL BILL NO. 2020-105

ORDINANCE NO

AN ORDINANCE approving an agreement and a work authorization with Allgeier, Martin and Associates, Inc. in the not to exceed amount of One Hundred Fifty-Six Thousand Eight Hundred and No/100 Dollars (\$156,800.00) for the Baker’s Branch Interceptor Replacement Project; and authorizing the City Manager or his designee to execute the same by and on behalf of the City of Joplin; and containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOPLIN, as follows:

Section 1. That the said agreement and work authorization by and between the City of Joplin and Allgeier, Martin and Associates, Inc. in the not to exceed amount of One Hundred Fifty-Six Thousand Eight Hundred and No/100 Dollars (\$156,800.00), a true and accurate copy of said agreement and work authorization being attached hereto; be and the same is hereby approved.

Section 2. That the City Manager of the City of Joplin, Missouri, or his designee, is hereby authorized and directed to execute said agreement and work authorization, or agreement and work authorization in substantially similar form, by and on behalf of the City of Joplin.

Section 3. That upon the final approval and acceptance of the consultant’s work under said contract, in substantial conformance with the attached agreement and work authorization, in writing by the Director of Public Works and his certification to the effect to the Director of Finance, the consultant shall be paid from the Wastewater Treatment Fund.

Section 4. That the City hereby declares that this Ordinance dealing with a public improvement, is an emergency within the meaning of Section 2.12 (6) of the Home Rule Charter of the City of Joplin, Missouri, and as such, this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
