### **SUMMARY**

This Council Bill authorizes the City Manager or his designee to approve Amendment 1 to Work Authorization BW-Conn-TC0606 with Bartlett & West, Inc. in the not to exceed amount of Two Hundred Forty-Eight Thousand Five Hundred Ninety-Six and 00/100 dollars (\$248,596.00) for engineering services for the Connecticut Avenue Widening project.

### **BACKGROUND**

In August 2014 the voters passed the Renewal of the Capital Improvement Sales Tax Program for an additional 10 years. One of the projects was the widening of Connecticut Avenue from 32<sup>nd</sup> St. to 44<sup>th</sup> St. In December 2016 City Council approved a work authorization with Bartlett & West, Inc. who was partnered with Allgeier Martin & Associates (AMA) for engineering services for this project. This work authorization included engineering consulting services for the full design, bidding and construction phase services for the intersection of 32<sup>nd</sup> and Connecticut, which is currently under construction as a cost share project between the City of Joplin and MoDOT. Also included in this work authorization was the completion of 60% Right of Way (ROW) plans for Connecticut Ave. between the 32<sup>nd</sup> St. Intersection project and I-44. The scope of work covered by this original work authorization has been completed, and an amendment is required to complete the final design plans for Connecticut.

Amendment 1 to Work Authorization BW-Conn-TC606 is for the completion of the final design plans from the 32<sup>nd</sup> & Connecticut intersection to I-44, along with engineering services through the bidding and contract award phase of the project. The project scope is to widen Connecticut Avenue to five lanes, with a 10' wide walking trail on the west side and a 6' wide sidewalk on the east side. City staff has reviewed the fees submitted by Bartlett & West and Allgeier Martin & Associates for the engineering services and found them to be within industry standards. The services included with this amendment are scheduled to be completed by March 2021.
