

COUNCIL BILL NO. 2021-114

ORDINANCE NO

AN ORDINANCE approving an agreement with Waste Corporation of Missouri (WCA) to provide disposal services of bulky items, limbs/brush and tires at a local transfer station by Joplin residents; and dealing generally with the payment for those services; and containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOPLIN, as follows:

Whereas, since April 1, 2016 the City of Joplin has managed a bulky item drop off program at an area transfer station for authorized Joplin residents through an exclusive agreement with WCA and said agreement expires on March 31, 2021.

Whereas the City of Joplin received three responsive, sealed bids on February 19, 2021 for Transfer Station drop off and disposal services.

Whereas, the City’s FY 2020-2021 budget provides for “City Wide Cleanup Program” from the Solid Waste Management Fund, and the FY 2021-2022 budget will provide for the same.

Section 1. That the said agreement by and between the City of Joplin and WCA a true and accurate copy of said agreement being attached hereto; be and the same is hereby approved.

Section 2. That the City of Joplin shall be responsible for paying one-half of the bid price (s) for the disposal of certain waste delivered to the Transfer Station by the residents of the City of Joplin.

Section 3. That the City Manager of the City of Joplin, Missouri, or his designee, is hereby authorized and directed to execute said agreement by and on behalf of the City of Joplin.

Section 4. Staff recommends approval of Council Bill 2021-114 on an emergency basis in accordance with Section 2.12 (1) of the Joplin City Charter, in that said ordinance provides for the protection and preservation of the public health of the community by ensuring the uninterrupted disposal of bulky items, limbs/brush, and tires thereby minimizing the proliferation of vermin and unsanitary conditions within the community.
