

**COUNCIL BILL NO. 2021-138**

**ORDINANCE NO**

AN ORDINANCE approving a Work Authorization AMA-PG21-001 with Allgeier, Martin and Associates, Inc. in the not to exceed amount of Three Hundred Thirty Four Thousand and 00/100 dollars (\$334,000.00) for professional engineering consulting services for the design of the rehabilitation of the parking garage at 6<sup>th</sup> Street and Virginia Avenue; and authorizing the City Manager or his designee to execute the same by and on behalf of the City of Joplin; and containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOPLIN, as follows:

Section 1. That the Work Authorization AMA-PG21-001 with Allgeier, Martin and Associates, Inc. in the not to exceed amount of Three Hundred Thirty Four Thousand and 00/100 dollars (\$334,000.00) for professional engineering consulting services for the rehabilitation of the parking garage at 6<sup>th</sup> Street and Virginia Avenue, a true and accurate copy of said work authorization being attached hereto and incorporated herein, be, and the same is hereby approved.

Section 2. That the City Manager of the City of Joplin, Missouri, or his designee, is hereby authorized and directed to execute said agreement, or agreement in substantially similar form, by and on behalf of the City of Joplin.

Section 3. That upon the final approval and acceptance of the consultant’s work under said contract, in substantial conformance with the attached work authorization, in writing by the Director of Public Works and his certification to the effect to the Director of Finance, the consultant shall be paid from the Capital Improvement Sales Tax fund.

Section 4. That the City hereby declares that this Ordinance dealing with a public improvement, is an emergency within the meaning of Section 2.12 (6) of the Home Rule Charter of the City of Joplin, Missouri, and as such, this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage. The reasoning for the emergency status is because this deals with public safety. The initial analysis of the garage should occur as soon as possible as the results may deem that immediate action needs to be taken such as closing a section of the structure until it can be fully rehabilitated.
