Case 017-22: 150 feet south of the intersection of S. Picher Ave. and Junge Blvd. - A request to vacate approximately 150 feet of street right-of-way- Joplin School District.

David Pettit, Director of Facilities with the Joplin Schools. The Joplin Schools owns both sides of the street and seeking to enhance our security for that area. The diesel pumps for our school buses sit right in the middle of that parking lot which are unsecure and has an underground tank. We are hopefully wanting to move the underground tank above ground and eliminate those in-ground tanks and allow us to move that fuel facility to a more secure location.
