

COUNCIL BILL NO. 2022-126

ORDINANCE NO

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the City of Joplin to enter into a work authorization with Allgeier, Martin and Associates, Inc., for engineering consultation services not to exceed the amount of One Hundred Seventeen Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$117,000.00) for Turkey Creek Waste Water Treatment Facility South Sludge Thickener and Oxidation Ditch Rotors on behalf of the City of Joplin and authorizing the City Manager or his designee to execute the same by and on behalf of the City of Joplin; and containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOPLIN, as follows:

Section 1. That the agreement by and between the City of Joplin and Allgeier, Martin and Associates, Inc., in the not to exceed amount of One Hundred Seventeen Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$117,000.00) for engineering services associated with the Turkey Creek Waste Water Treatment Facility South Sludge Thickener and Oxidation Ditch Rotors on behalf of the City of Joplin; true and accurate copy of said work authorization being attached hereto and incorporated herein, be, and the same is hereby approved.

Section 2. That the City Manager of the City of Joplin, Missouri, or his designee, is hereby authorized and directed to execute said work authorization, or agreement in substantially similar form, by and on behalf of the City of Joplin.

Section 3. That upon final approval and acceptance of the consultant’s work under said contract, in substantial conformance with the attached work authorization, in writing to the Director of Public Works and his certification to the effect to the Director of Finance, the consultant shall be paid by the Sanitary Sewer Fund.

Section 4. That the City of Joplin hereby declares that this Ordinance, being an Ordinance dealing with public improvements, is considered an emergency within the meaning of Section 2.12 (6) of the Home Rule Charter of the City of Joplin, Missouri, and the Council hereby declares that this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage. Specifically, this council bill needs to be approved in order to design projects that affect structural and safety issues.
