

COUNCIL BILL NO. 2022-147

ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the acceptance of an agreement by and between the City of Joplin and Crawford, Murphy & Tilly, Inc. in the not to exceed amount of Five Hundred Twelve Thousand and 00/00 Dollars (\$512,00.00) for the Terminal Area Master Plan (TAMP) Design Services at the Joplin Regional Airport; and containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOPLIN, MISSOURI, as follows:

Section 1. That an agreement by and between the City of Joplin and Crawford, Murphy & Tilly, Inc., for Engineering Design Services in the not to exceed amount of Five Hundred Twelve Thousand and 00/00 Dollars (\$512,00.00) for the Terminal Area Master Plan Design Services at the Joplin Regional Airport a true and accurate copy of said agreement being attached here to and incorporated herein, is hereby approved.

Section 2. That the City Manager or his Designee is hereby authorized and directed to execute said Agreement by and on behalf of the City of Joplin, Missouri.

Section 3. That upon the final approval and acceptance of the consultants work under said contract, in substantial conformance with the attached agreement, in writing by the Director of Public Works and his certification to the effect to the Director of Finance, the consultant shall be paid from the Airport Fund.

Section 4. That the City of Joplin declares that this ordinance relating to public improvement is an emergency within the meaning of Section 2.12(6) of the HOME RULE CHARTER of the City of Joplin, Missouri and the Council hereby declares that this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after passage. Specifically, this Council Bill needs to be approved in order to allow the design services to be completed within funding time limitations.
