

COUNCIL BILL NO. 2022-609**ORDINANCE NO.**

AN ORDINANCE approving the applications of Active Lifestyle Events Inc for Joplin Memorial Run; Rufus Racing, LLC for Summer Roundup Triathlon; Ozark Christian College for a marketing campaigns for their 2023 conference series; Midwestern Built CrossFit for Monster Games; Joplin Disc Golf Club for the 18th Annual Four States Open; 4 State Trucks for Guilty by Association; Keg Media for Mother Road Mayhem; East Town Dreams District for Joplin Juneteenth Regional Black Expo; Neosho Arts Council for ArtCon 2023; Historic Murphysburg Preservation, Inc for Murphysburg Heritage Tourism marketing; JOMO Pride, Inc. for JOMO PrideFest 2023; Emancipation Celebration Committee for Emancipation "Park Days" Celebration; Freedom of Flight Museum for a museum marketing campaign; Joplin Trails Coalition for marketing the Jasper Vintage and Maple Leaf tours; North Heights Neighborhood for North Heights Porchfest; and the Celebrations Commission for a sesquicentennial community concert, for utilization of FY2023 Festivals and Celebrations support pursuant to Ordinance No. 2000-148, as authorized by the voters on November 7, 2000; authorizing the City Manager to execute appropriate agreements with each such organization for the utilization of such funds and containing an emergency clause.

WHEREAS, the voters of the City of Joplin approved an increase in the Occupational License Tax for transient sleeping accommodations at an election held on November 7, 2000; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Ordinance No. 2000-148, a portion of said funds are to be utilized for festivals or celebrations intended to attract visitors from the region to the City and other related activities in the City; and,

WHEREAS, the Convention & Visitors Bureau Advisory Board established an application procedure and reviewed the applications of numerous organizations, and have recommended to the Council that certain festivals, celebrations, events, and attractions be funded utilizing a portion of said proceeds; and,

WHEREAS, after having a Public Hearing thereon, as required by said ordinance, the Council of the City of Joplin desires to utilize a portion of the proceeds from said tax in accordance with the recommendations of the Convention & Visitors Bureau Advisory Board.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOPLIN, MISSOURI, as follows:

Section 1. That the applications of Joplin Memorial Run, Active Lifestyle Events Inc, May 2023, in the amount of Five Thousand Five Hundred dollars (\$5,500); Summer Roundup Triathlon, Rufus Racing, LLC, July 8-9, 2023, in the amount of Five Thousand Six Hundred dollars (\$5,600); OCC Conference Series marketing, Ozark Christian College, 2023 conference series, in the amount of Sixteen Thousand Two Hundred and Seventy-Five dollars (\$16,275); Monster Games, Midwestern Built CrossFit, July 2023, in the amount of Thirteen Thousand Four Hundred and Seventy-Five dollars (\$13,475); 18th Annual Four States Open, Joplin Disc Golf Club, September 22-24, 2023, in the amount of Six

Thousand dollars (\$6,000); Guilty by Association, 4 State Trucks, September 22-23, 2023, in the amount of Twenty-Five Thousand dollars (\$25,000); Mother Road Mayhem, Keg Media, May 5-7, 2023, in the amount of Three Thousand dollars (\$3,000); Juneteenth Regional Black Expo, East Town Dreams District, June 16-18, 2023, in the amount of Two Thousand dollars (\$2,000); ArtCon 2023, Neosho Arts Council, February 4, 2023, in the amount of Three Thousand Four Hundred dollars (\$3,400); Murphysburg Heritage Tourism, Historic Murphysburg Preservation, Inc, July 15, 2023, in the amount of Two Thousand dollars (\$2,000); JOMO PrideFest, JOMO Pride, Inc., September 8-10, 2023, in the amount of Seven Thousand Five Hundred dollars (\$7,500); Emancipation "Park Days" Celebration, Emancipation Celebration Committee, August 4-6, 2023, in the amount of Three Thousand dollars (\$3,000); Freedom of Flight Museum promotions, Freedom of Flight Museum, 2023, in the amount of Two Thousand dollars (\$2,000); Jasper Vintage and Maple Leaf Tours, Joplin Trails Coalition, May 20, and October 13, 2023, respectively, in the amount of One Thousand One Hundred and Forty-Two dollars (\$1,142); North Heights Porchfest, North Heights Neighborhood, October 3, 2023, in the amount of Seven Hundred dollars (\$700); and Community Concert weekend, Joplin Celebrations Commission, July or August 2023, in the amount of Twenty-Five Thousand dollars (\$25,000) for utilization of FY2023 Festivals and Celebrations support pursuant to Ordinance No. 2000-148, as authorized by the voters on November 7, 2000, be and the same are hereby approved.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute appropriate Agreements, by and on behalf of the City of Joplin, with each said organization for the expenditure of said funds in accordance with the recommendation of the Joplin Convention & Visitors Bureau Advisory Board, and, in accordance with Ordinance No. 2000-148.

Section 3. This Ordinance is declared by the City Council to be an emergency within this meaning of Section 2.12 (4), of the Home Rule Charter of the City of Joplin, Missouri, in order to continue the day-to-day operations of the City and as such shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
