SUMMARY

The following is a resolution that authorizes the submittal of the HOME-ARP allocation plan to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for the Joplin HOME Consortium American Recovery Plan (HOME ARP) Program as substantial amendment to the 2021 Action Plan in the amount of \$1,735,017.00.

BACKGROUND

As required for funds appropriated under Section 3205 of the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (P.L. 117-2) (ARP) for the HOME Investment Partnerships Program (HOME) the City of Joplin as the Participation Jurisdiction of the HOME Consortium has prepared the HOME-ARP allocation plan in accordance with the CPD-21-10 notice. This plan was prepared in accordance with the consultation requirements of said CPD notice and the City of Joplin Entitlement Program Citizen Participation Plan. Allocations to eligible activities to benefit qualifying populations were made in consideration with requirements of the funding as outlined in the federal register notice, gap analysis conducted by staff and with required consultation with the Continuum of Care (Homeless Coalition). Notice for agencies to apply for funding will be advertised following approval of federal assistance agreement between the United State Department of Housing and Urban development and the City. Competitive applications will be awarded following rank and review by committee consisting of City staff and homelessness service providers whose agencies do not apply for funding.

The HOME-ARP allocation for the Joplin HOME Consortium is \$1,736,017.00.

RECOMMENDATION
