

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-015

A RESOLUTION of the City of Joplin, Missouri, Authorizing the City Manager to submit a resolution of support for the application to the Missouri Department of Transportation, Governor’s Transportation Cost Share Program, for grant funds for the Zora Widening Improvements project, from Rangeline Road to MO-249.

WHEREAS, in August 2014 the voters passed the Renewal of the Capital Improvements Sales Tax Program for an additional 10 years.

WHEREAS, the widening and improvement of Zora Street from Rangeline Road to MO-249 was included on the list of projects approved by the voters.

WHEREAS, the Missouri Department of Transportation has funding available through the Governor’s Transportation Cost Share Program to provide financial assistance for public road and bridge projects.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOPLIN, MISSOURI, as follows:

Section 1. That the City Council of the City of Joplin appreciates support from the Missouri Department of Transportation and understands the importance of improving public roads and bridges.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed, upon recommendation and approval of the City Council, to submit a resolution of support as part of the grant application packet to the Missouri Department of Transportation, Governor’s Transportation Cost Share Program.
