SUMMARY

This Resolution authorizes the City Manager to submit a resolution of support, as part of the grant application packet, to the Missouri Department of Transportation, Governor's Transportation Cost Share Program, for grant funding for the Zora Widening Improvements project, from Rangeline Road to MO-249, with the matching funds covered by the City's Capital Improvement Sales Tax funds.

BACKGROUND

In August 2014, the voters passed the Renewal of the Capital Improvement Sales Tax Program for an additional 10 years. One of the projects was the widening of Zora Street from Rangeline Road to MO-249.

A funding opportunity is available through the Governor's Transportation Cost Share Program to provide financial assistance for public road and bridge projects. This grant has the potential to pay for up to 50% of the construction costs for this project. The City of Joplin would be responsible for the remaining project costs including design, right-of way, and engineering costs, and will be covered by Capital Improvement Sales Tax funds.
