

COUNCIL BILL NO. 2022- 610

ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE approving the issuance of a Purchase Order to U.S. Digital Designs to cover the purchase of fire station alerting package as approved in the Annual Budget of the City of Joplin for the Fiscal Year 2021-2022 as adopted by Ordinance 2021-523 on October 18, 2021, to adjust appropriations and containing an emergency clause.

WHEREAS, in the FY2021-2022 budget process, Council approved and budgeted funds to cover the purchase of fire station alerting.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOPLIN, MISSOURI, as follows:

Section 1. That a Purchase Order issued to U.S. Digital Designs for the amount of Three Hundred Forty-one Thousand, One Hundred Seventeen Dollars, Seventy Cents (\$341,117.70), covering the cost and installation of fire station alerting for all 6 fire stations and the future fire station 7, be and the same is, hereby approved.

Section 2. That the City hereby declares this Ordinance, being an ordinance dealing generally with payment of current city government expenses, to be an emergency within the meaning of Section 2.12(3) of the HOME RULE CHARTER of the City of Joplin, Missouri, and as such, this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
