SUMMARY

This Council Bill authorizes a Program Services Contract between the City of Joplin and the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services regarding the WIC Program for contract year 2022-2023

BACKGROUND

This DHSS contract provides funding from the state for this program. This contract is the annual renewal of the agreement between the DHSS and the City of Joplin Health Department to provide nutritional assistance and certain medical services in connection with the Women, Infant & Children (WIC) project. The City Council has previously approved similar contracts.

The contract calls for the City of Joplin Health Department to provide WIC services that include food instruments (checks) redeemable for specific nutritious foods, nutrition education and counseling, breastfeeding counseling and certain medical services for income eligible women and children in Jasper county. The local agency plan calls for the city to provide WIC services for up to 35,557 clients and for a total cost reimbursement of up to \$611,813.

Revenues and expenses are budgeted in the remainder of the current year budget as well as the 2022-2023 city budget.

The period for this agreement is October 1, 2022 through September 30, 2023 and the total anticipated reimbursement from this agreement is \$611,813. No local match is required for participation in this contract.

FUNDING SOURCE

The source of funding is the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services contract.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends adoption of this Council Bill on an emergency basis to prevent delay of implementation of contract.
