ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE Authorizing a work authorization with Allgeier, Martin and Associates, Inc. for engineering consulting services in the not to exceed amount of Two Hundred Fifty-Four Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$254,000.00) for design of the Filmore Bridge and Tin Cup Lift Station Improvements project, authorizing the City Manager or his designee to execute the same by and on behalf of the City of Joplin, and containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOPLIN, MISSOURI, as follows:

Section 1. That a work authorization with Allgeier, Martin and Associates, Inc. for engineering consulting services in the not to exceed amount of Two Hundred Fifty-Four Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$254,000.00) for design of the Filmore Bridge and Tin Cup Lift Station Improvements project; a true and accurate copy of said agreement being attached hereto and incorporated as "Exhibit A," be and the same is hereby approved.

Section 2. That the City Manager of the City of Joplin, Missouri, or his designee, is hereby authorized and directed to execute said agreement, or agreement in substantially similar form, by and on behalf of the City of Joplin.

Section 3. That upon the final approval and acceptance of the consultant's work under said contract, in substantial conformance with the attached work authorization, in writing by the Director of Public Works and his certification to the effect to the Director of Finance, the consultant shall be paid from the Sanitary Sewer fund.

Section 4. That the City hereby declares this Ordinance, being an ordinance for infrastructure improvements and dealing with appropriations, the availability of equipment, to be an emergency within the meaning of Section 2.12(6) of the HOME RULE CHARTER of the City of Joplin, Missouri, and as such, this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage. Specifically, these improvements need to be designed prior to construction of the upcoming Tin Cup Parallel Force Main project.
