### **SUMMARY**

This Council Bill approves the issuance of a Purchase Order to Viking Cives Midwest (Sourcewell Contract #080818-VCM) in the amount of Two Hundred Thirty-Nine Thousand Five Hundred Ninety-Six Dollars (\$239,596.00) for the purchase of a 2024 International HV507 SFA Dump Truck with snowplow and salt spreader (Chassis & Body).

### **BACKGROUND**

During the Budget process last year, Public Works identified this dump truck as the next to be replaced for the street fleet. The Street Maintenance Division needs to replace this dump truck with snow removal equipment as well. The truck being replaced is a 1999 International Dump Truck. This vehicle and equipment being replaced by the Street Division will be transferred to the Parks Department for continued use.

The City utilized Sourcewell contract #080818-VCM to find a suitable replacement for the dump truck. After careful consideration, Public Works Department staff chose to use Sourcewell to purchase the new dump truck from Viking Cives Midwest. This equipment meets city specification and mirrors existing equipment. The purchase of this truck was approved in the FY 2022-2023 budget. We are seeking emergency approval, due to this bid being held only until February 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2023, due to supply and demand.

### **FUNDING SOURCE**

Transportation Sales Tax.

### **RECOMMENDATION**

Staff recommends adoption of this Council Bill on an Emergency basis; being an ordinance dealing with appropriations, the availability of the equipment, to be an emergency within the meaning of Section 2.12(4) of the HOME RULE CHARTER of the City of Joplin, Missouri, and as such, this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
