SUMMARY

This Council Bill is a supplemental agreement by and between the City of Joplin and Crawford, Murphy & Tilly, Inc., for Engineering Design Services not to exceed the amount of ninety-five thousand six hundred thirty-eight and 27/100 dollars (\$95,638.27) for the SRE Building at the Joplin Regional Airport.

BACKGROUND

On July 15, 2022 Joplin City Council authorized an agreement by and between the City of Joplin and Crawford, Murphy & Tilly, Inc. for Engineering Design Services for the ARFF building at the Joplin Regional Airport. The agreement contained a supplement that could be executed at a later date. The supplement authorized the design services for the SRE portion of a joint ARFF/SRE building if additional federal funding became available. Additional funding is now available through the Bipartisan Infrastructure Legislation Act (BIL) of which the design of the SRE portion is eligible. This grant is based on a 95/5 Federal/Local share. The Federal share will be \$90,856.36 and the local share will be \$4,781.91 for a total project cost of \$95,638.27.

FUNDING SOURCE

This Council Bill includes a budget amendment increasing revenue for the grant amount of \$90,856.00 and increasing expenses for the total project cost of \$95,638.00.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends adoption of this Council Bill on an Emergency basis, being an ordinance related to public improvement, within the meaning of Section 2.12(6) of the Home Rule Charter of the City of Joplin, Missouri, and, as such, this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage. Specifically, this council bill needs to be approved to allow design services to be completed within funding time limitations.
