

COUNCIL BILL NO. 2023-108

ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the acceptance of a supplemental agreement by and between the City of Joplin and Crawford, Murphy & Tilly, Inc., in the amount of ninety-five thousand six hundred thirty-eight and 27/100 dollars (\$95,638.27) for Engineering Design Services for the Snow Removal Equipment (SRE) storage portion of the Aircraft Rescue and Fire Fighting (ARFF) Building at the Joplin Regional Airport; amending the Annual Budget of the City of Joplin for the Fiscal Year 2022-2023 as adopted by Ordinance 2022-161 on October 17, 2022; and, containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOPLIN, MISSOURI, as follows:

Section 1. That Supplemental Agreement No. 1 by and between the City of Joplin and Crawford, Murphy & Tilly, Inc., for Engineering Design Services not to exceed the amount of ninety-five thousand six hundred thirty-eight and 27/100 dollars (\$95,638.27) for the SRE Building at the Joplin Regional Airport a true and accurate copy of said agreement being attached hereto and incorporated herein, is hereby approved.

Section 2. That the City Manager or his Designee is hereby authorized and directed to execute said agreement by and on behalf of the City of Joplin, Missouri.

Section 3. That fiscal year 2022-2023 budgeted appropriations as adopted by Ordinance 2022-161 be amended by increasing revenue by the total amount of Ninety Thousand Eight Hundred Fifty-Six Dollars and No Cents (\$90,856.00) and by increasing appropriations by the total amount of Ninety-Five Thousand Six Hundred Thirty-Eight Dollars and No Cents (\$95,638.00).

Section 4. That the Director of Finance is hereby directed to make all necessary entries on the City records to show the increase in appropriations.

Section 5. That the City of Joplin declares that this ordinance relating to public improvement is an emergency within the meaning of Section 2.12(6) of the HOME RULE CHARTER of the City of Joplin, Missouri and the Council hereby declares that this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after passage. Specifically, this council bill needs to be approved in order to allow design services to be completed within funding time limitations.
