SUMMARY

The following is a resolution that authorizes the filing of a substantial amendment to the One Year Action Plan with the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for the City of Joplin’s Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program and Home Investment Partnership (HOME) Program for fiscal year 2019 to include additional activities for the CDBG-CV allocation.

The only changes to the plan are with respect to the CDBG-CV program. The 2019 HOME & CDBG programs previously approved are completed and funds have been spent.

BACKGROUND

As authorized by the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act), Public Law 116-136, the City of Joplin has received a special allocation of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG-CV). In accordance with the Citizen Participation Plan and the Code of Federal Regulations, the funding of new programs constitute a substantial amendment to the fiscal year 2019 One Year Action plan previously approved. Funded programs can be found on the summary of the amended plan and include public services, and administration.

The total amount of CDBG-CV remaining in the 2019 Action Plan Substantial Amendment is \$556,825.00.
