

COUNCIL BILL NO. 2023-118 ORDINANCE NO

AN ORDINANCE approving a construction agreement with Vance Brothers Inc. in the amount of Six Hundred Seventy-Eight Thousand Six Hundred Forty-Six and 20/100 dollars (\$678,646.20) for the Microsurfacing 2023 project; and authorizing the City Manager or his designee to execute the same by and on behalf of the City of Joplin; and, containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOPLIN, as follows:

Section 1. That the construction agreement between the City of Joplin and Vance Brothers Inc. in the amount of Six Hundred Seventy-Eight Thousand Six Hundred Forty-Six and 20/100 dollars (\$678,646.20) for the Microsurfacing 2023 project, a true and accurate copy of said agreement being attached hereto; be the same and is hereby approved.

Section 2. That the City Manager of the City of Joplin, Missouri or his designee, is hereby authorized and directed to execute said agreement, or agreement in substantially similar form, by and on behalf of the City of Joplin.

Section 3. That upon the final approval and acceptance of the contractor's work under said contract, in substantial conformance with the attached exhibits, in writing by the Director of Public Works, and his certification to that effect to the Director of Finance, the contractor shall be paid out of the Transportation Sales Tax, appropriations having been approved in the 2022-2023 city budget.

Section 4. That the City hereby declares that this Ordinance dealing with a public improvement, is an emergency within the meaning of Section 2.12(6) of the HOME RULE CHARTER of the City of Joplin, Missouri, and as such, this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage. Specifically, this ordinance approves construction to begin immediately in the optimal construction time during the calendar year.
