

**RESOLUTION NO. 2023-012**

**A RESOLUTION** of the City of Joplin, Missouri, approving the final American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Spending Plan in order to comply with the federal grant regulations and established timeline for these funds awarded directly to the City.

WHEREAS, the City developed a list of partially-funded or unfunded Community Projects based on community input through various master plans and action plans; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council and the city staff of Joplin prioritized the Community Projects based on various categories, which has resulted in a recommended ARPA Spending Plan and an ARPA Alternate Spending Plan; and,

WHEREAS, the ARPA Projects will have a significant long-term economic and public service impact for the Community; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council and the city staff of Joplin prioritized the remaining unfunded projects that fall within the federal grant regulations; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council of Joplin, Missouri, desires to approve the final American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Spending Plan to comply with the federal grant regulations and established timeline of this award to achieve long-term improvement and job enhancement or job creation for our community.

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOPLIN, MISSOURI**, as follows:

Section 1. The City of Joplin, Missouri hereby approves the final prioritized American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Spending Plan as set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto.

Section 2. The City of Joplin, Missouri further hereby approves the final prioritized American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Alternate Spending Plan as set forth in Exhibit B attached hereto.

Section 3. The City of Joplin, Missouri is committed to completing the required projects as set forth in the grant regulations.

Section 4. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.
