**SUMMARY**

This Council Bill approves an agreement by and between Reinbold Electric, Inc, in the amount of Four Hundred Twenty-Four Thousand Eight Hundred and 00/100 Dollars (\$424,800.00) for the purchase and installation of a new ALCMS at the Joplin Regional Airport.

**BACKGROUND**

A request for bidders was advertised for this project on July 22, 2023, for a bid opening date of August 10, 2023. There was one bid received. The bid amount exceeded the engineers estimate. However, the FAA agreed with the airport construction consultant's recommendation to award the contract to Reinbold Electric, Inc.

Total project costs for this project and the sister project (Air Traffic Control Tower Equipment Replacement) amounts to \$1,060,310. These costs will be covered by an \$860,000 FAA Grant at 100% federal share. The remaining \$200,310 will be funded by a Fiscal Year 24 grant at a 95/5 federal to local share. This results in a federal share of \$190,295 and local share of \$10,015.

**FUNDING SOURCE**

FAA AIP Grant 3-29-0037-056-2023, Airport Fund

**RECOMMENDATION**

Staff recommends adoption of this Council Bill on an Emergency basis, being an Ordinance related to public improvement, within the meaning of Section 2.12(6) of the Home Rule Charter of the City of Joplin, and, as such, this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage. Specifically, this council bill needs to be approved on an emergency basis to allow construction to begin within FAA funding time limitations.
