

COUNCIL BILL NO. 2023-146

ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the acceptance of an agreement by and between the City of Joplin and Crossland Construction, Inc., in the amount of Seven Million Nine Hundred Forty-Five Thousand Two Hundred Thirty-Nine and 12/100 Dollars (\$7,945,239.12) for Construction of the Aircraft Rescue and Fire Fighting/Snow Removal Equipment (ARFF/SRE) building at the Joplin Regional Airport; authorizing the City Manager or his designee to execute the agreement by and on behalf of the City of Joplin; amending the Annual Budget of the City of Joplin for the Fiscal Year 2022-2023 as adopted by Ordinance 2022-161 on October 17, 2022; and containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOPLIN, MISSOURI, as follows:

Section 1. That the agreement by and between the City of Joplin and Crossland Construction, Inc., in the amount of Seven Million Nine Hundred Forty-Five Thousand Two Hundred Thirty-Nine and 12/100 Dollars (\$7,945,239.12) for Construction of the Aircraft Rescue and Fire Fighting/Snow Removal Equipment (ARFF/SRE) building at the Joplin Regional Airport; a true and accurate copy of said agreement being attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit "A", is hereby approved.

Section 2. That the City Manager or his Designee is hereby authorized and directed to execute said agreement, or an agreement in substantially similar form, by and on behalf of the City of Joplin, Missouri.

Section 3. That fiscal year 2022-2023 budgeted revenue and appropriations as adopted by Ordinance 2022-161 be amended by increasing revenue by the total amount of Eight Million Two Hundred Twenty-Six Thousand Five Hundred Thirty-Seven and No Cents (\$8,226,537.00) and by increasing appropriations by the total amount of Eight Million Six Hundred Eighty-One Thousand Seven Hundred Ten Dollars and No Cents (\$8,681,710.00).

Section 4. That the Director of Finance is hereby directed to make all necessary entries on the City records to show the increase in revenue and appropriations.

Section 5. That the City of Joplin declares that this ordinance relating to public improvement is an emergency within the meaning of Section 2.12(6) of the HOME RULE CHARTER of the City of Joplin, Missouri and the Council hereby declares that this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after passage. Specifically, this council bill needs to be approved to allow construction services to be completed within funding time limitations.
