

**JOPLIN CITY COUNCIL
AUGUST 8, 2022
SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES**

Mayor Lawson called the August 8, 2022, Joplin City Council special meeting to order at 5:45 p.m.

Answering Roll Call were Council Members: Charles Copple, Keenan Cortez, Josh DeTar, Mark Farnham, Doug Lawson, Gary Shaw, Kate Spencer, Phil Stinnett, and Christina Williams. Also, in attendance were City Manager Nick Edwards and City Attorney Peter Edwards.

The City Clerk's office has received the official results of the August 2, 2022, Election as verified by the Jasper and Newton County Clerks.

It is found and declared that the results are as follows:

Proposition Public Safety received 3,587 yes votes and 4,645 no votes.

The measure needed a simple majority for passage. Proposition Public Safety failed.

For the record, 8,232 ballots were cast in this election.

Motion by Mr. Cortez, second by Dr. Farnham to accept the August 2, 2022, election results as submitted. Voting in favor were Council Members: Cortez, Copple, DeTar, Farnham, Lawson, Shaw, Spencer, Stinnett, and Williams, 9.
