ORDINANCES – EMERGENCY

COUNCIL BILL NO. 2023-516

Mr. Copple introduced Council Bill No. 2023-516 - AN ORDINANCE levying taxes in the City of Joplin, Missouri for the year 2023 in the amount of Seventeen and Forty-Six Hundredths Cents (\$0.1746) on One Hundred Dollars of valuation of all real property in said City, and levying taxes in the Joplin Public Library District for the year 2023 in the amount of Twenty-Four and Fifty-Nine Hundredths Cents (\$0.2459) on One Hundred Dollars of valuation of all real property in said District; and, containing an emergency clause. Motion by Mr. Copple, second by Mr. Cortez that Council Bill No. 2023-516 be passed on an emergency basis. Voting in favor were Council Members: Copple, Cortez, DeTar, Farnham, Lawson, Shaw, Spencer, Stinnett, and Williams, 9. Nays: 0. The Council Bill was declared adopted and entitled **Ordinance No. 2023-128.**
