REPORTS AND COMMUNICATIONS

News from the Public Information Office

A Public Meeting focusing on the next and final phase of the Connecticut Widening Program is set for Thursday, October 26, at Immanuel Lutheran Church, 2616 Connecticut Avenue. This open house public meeting with City engineers and construction contractor representatives is set for 4:30 p.m. to 6 p.m.

This project focuses on the area from 32nd Street to the I-44 Bridge and will reconstruct and widen Connecticut Avenue to a 5-lane roadway with curb and gutter, including a dual-use 10-foot-wide sidewalk/bike trail on the west side of the roadway and a 6-foot-wide sidewalk on the east side of the roadway.

Citizens may drop by any time during these hours to view the final plans and ask questions about the upcoming construction project.

Widening Connecticut was originally introduced and supported by voters at the 2004 election for the Capital Improvement Sales Tax. With continued citizens' support, the project has been done in phases, including the addition of the railroad overpass near 26th Street. This is the final phase of widening Connecticut Avenue from Campbell Parkway to 44th Street, providing an efficient and safe north/south corridor for our community.

Tree pruning is not recommended in the fall, but cutting dead limbs and branches can be done any time of the year. So if planning to work on your fall outdoor chores, remember the monthly tree limb drop-off program is open on Friday, October 20 and Saturday, October 21 to take your limbs and branches.

The site will be open from 8:30 a.m. to 2 p.m. and is located at 1702 North Schifferdecker Avenue, approximately six-tenths of a mile north of Belle Center Road on the west side of Schifferdecker Avenue. This free drop-off service is for Joplin residents only. Professional contractors will not be allowed to dump.

This is the last scheduled drop-off weekend for 2023. The City may open this site following a weather event for residents to dispose of branches. Announcements of these openings are announced through local news stations, the City's website and the City's Facebook page.


