



On March 8, 2022, Officer Jake Reed and Corporal Benjamin Cooper were dispatched to The Buckle, a clothing store located at 405 Geneva in reference to a subject causing a disturbance in the business. Officer Reed and Corporal Benjamin Cooper attempted to place the suspect under arrest a distance away from the business. The suspect resisted and during the struggle pulled a pistol that was concealed on his person and shot Officer Reed and Corporal Cooper. The suspect then stole Corporal Cooper's patrol vehicle and fled the scene.

Captain William Davis exchanged gunfire with the suspect, killing him and ending the rampage after Officer Rick Hirshey was shot by the suspect while trying to prevent him from stealing a citizen's vehicle.

Officer Reed succumbed to his injuries on March 9, and was kept on life support until March 11, 2022, donating his organs to save the lives of others.
